

What is a walkable campus?

Campus core as vehicle-free as possible Reduced parking
Pathway network Adequate shade Human scale Clear wayfinding
Pedestrian movement as primary mode of transportation
Memorable Ease of access Safe Places to wait Consistent paving materials
Defined routes Limited vehicular through traffic Clear points of entry
Parking on the periphery Minimize conflicts with pedestrians and vehicles



What is a walkable campus?

A **walkable** campus considers the needs of walkers first when organizing the movement of people, bicycles, cars, and buses on the school grounds.




Walkable campus design principles

- Safe spaces
















Safe Drop-off Zones











